Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan Goal

- 50% of students in grades 9-10 will show a year's worth of growth (fall to spring assessment) towards the grade-level college readiness benchmarks on the PSAT in the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) and Math portions of the exam.
- 50% of students in grade 11 will show a year's worth of growth (fall to spring assessments) towards the college readiness benchmarks on the PSAT/SAT in the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW) and Math portions of the exam.
